The candidates selected were: Kali Crowley and Braylee Peterson from Cedar High School and Brooklyn Rushton from Canyon View High School.

Burke Hamilton had arranged with the two local high schools to attend their award ceremony on May 23<sup>rd,</sup> along with chapter president Rick Perry to present the awards. Burke had a last-minute conflict that required him to be out of town, so Rick represented our chapter and presented the awards. All three young women were excited and grateful to receive the scholarships.
