John C. Fremont Memorial. Seeking a suitable railroad route through the central Rockies, John C. Fremont and company reached Parowan February 6, 1854.

These are Fremont own words, "We were all so feeble we could barely drag ourselves down the trail, but the Mormons took us in one by two in each home, fed us and nursed us back to health."

On this spot Fremont himself was nursed back to health by Mrs. John C. L. Smith, who later became Mrs. Wm. McGregor.

This location was donated to the Sons of the Utah Pioneer, By the Laurence J. and Augusta D. Adams family.
